



Position Title: Youth Mentor

The Need

Job summary

The Youth Mentor position seeks to ensure that s/he establishes and fosters a long-term relationship with the young adults in the organization. The job activities include creating a positive relationship with the youth, helping youth to establish personal goals and create action plans, motivating and inspiring youth, and implementing youth programs as designed by Kairos International.

The Work

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Organization and Leadership

- Locate Youth that are assigned to the organization through community mobilization
- Maintain, in confidentiality, individual youth case files at the organization
- Serve as a role model to the youth
- Provide behavior management for at risk youths and mitigate issues among them

Coordination

- Act as a liaison between youth, youth's family, employers, and community agencies
- Develop individual achievement plans for each youth
- Advice team lead on external youth activities that Kairos youth can benefit from
- Document success stories and share with respective offices
- Develop daily, weekly, and monthly field activity plans as deemed fit
- Implement field activities in collaboration with youth and all concerned stakeholders

Mentorship

- Provide one-on-one mentoring sessions to the Kairos youth
- Develop and maintain mentorship work plans
- Conduct follow up sessions with youth while in their communities or homes
- Follow up and create an alumni group of youth after Kairos graduation
- Encourage and use various means of communication (written, spoken, etc) during activities to ensure the self-expression of the young adult
- Assist in establishing a community network

Reporting and Referrals

- Weekly/ daily/ monthly report writing
- Make recommendations of which youth require specialized attention or help
- Refer youth to appropriate services through adequate referral system in place.
- Recognize emergency situation (medical care, protection issues) and make appropriate referrals

Data Collection

- Produce weekly activity reports and contribute in the development of organizational reports
- Develop and run a data base of information regarding the youth attached to you
- Maintain complete documentation for each youth activity conducted
- Ensure proper field data collection using provided tools
- * Carry out any other duties as requested by Management
